Junior Does, Senior Does, and Combined Bucks

Location: El Dorado County Fairgrounds, 100 Placerville Drive, Placerville, CA 95667

When: May 14, 2022 Check In -- 7:30 am Show Starts -- 9:00 am

Judges: Ring 1 – Rebekah Clarke Ring 2 – Russell Sorbo

Senior Does will be first in the morning; no pre-show milk out will be required.

Junior Does will follow (maybe before lunch depending on time for senior does)

Combined Bucks will be after lunch

For the TMGR/MDGA rings, breed order will be Mini Nubians, Mini Oberhasli, All Other Minis.

1. Under 18 months
2. 18 months to under 24 months
3. 2 years to under 3 years
4. 3 years to under 4 years
5. 4 years to under 5 years
6. 5 years and older

Junior Doe Classes*:

7. 0 to under 2 months
8. 2 months to under 4 months
9. 4 month to under 9 months
10. 9 months to under 12 months
11. 12 months to under 18 months
12. 18 months to under 24 months

**Age of goat on day of show*

Combined Buck Classes*:

13. Jr Kids (under 5 months)
14. Sr Kids (5 month to under 12 months)
15. Yearling (12 months to under 2 years)
16. 2 years to under 3 years
17. 3 years to under 4 years
18. 4 years and older

Registering for the Show:

Early submission will be done online (<https://stitchnthyme.weebly.com/goat-show-info.html>), payment through PayPal (friends or Family to StitchNThyme.Farms@gmail.com) or bring payment (cash or check) the day of the show. Early registration is appreciated and must be submitted by midnight on May 8. Fee is \$10/goat/ring or \$15/goat/both rings. PayPal is the preferred method of payment.

If you do not submit registrations by May 8, please be prepared to be here promptly at 7:30 am for check in and there will be an additional late fee of \$2/goat/ring. Payment can be made the day of the show (cash or check) or by PayPal to stitchnthyme.farms@gmail.com.

Facilities-The show will be in Pavillion D, which is fully covered. This is a show out of your trailer/car event. A small number of pens can be provided but must be reserved by April 15th. If you wish to arrive Friday evening, camping at the fairgrounds is an option. Overnight fees are \$40/night, for RV, tent, or sleep in your truck camping. Please contact us for more info on camping.
